1 WHEREAS, The Tomball High School Junior Reserve Officers'

11 Unit for the past two years, and its drill team recently finished
12 10th in state competition; moreover, the 165 cadets at Tomball
13 accumulated a total of 2,200 community service hours in 2008; and
