RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Residents of League City are marking the centennial
 of the Butler Building, the oldest brick structure on the mainland
 of Galveston County; and

WHEREAS, Completed in 1909, the Butler Building 4 was 5 constructed by George Washington Butler, who came to the area with his pioneer family as a child in the mid-19th century; after the 6 7 Civil War, Mr. Butler became a prominent cattleman, and went on to serve as Galveston County commissioner and as postmaster for the 8 community first known as Butler's Ranch or Clear Creek; 9 in addition, Mr. Butler built the first school, housed in a log cabin, 10 11 and was instrumental in the development of the bridge that joined 12 Galveston with the mainland; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Butler convinced Galveston financier John 13 14 League to buy land near the Butler home and plat streets for the town that would be renamed League City; Mr. Butler also worked to 15 16 bring a bank to the community, promising the Galveston firm of Hutchins and Sealy that he would construct a first-class facility; 17 designed by architect Andrew Dow, the L-shaped Butler Building 18 initially housed the Citizen's State Bank, a drug store, a hardware 19 20 store, and professional offices; and

21 WHEREAS, In later years, the Butler Building fell into 22 disrepair, until it was purchased and renovated by a local 23 architect; today, the elegant building again houses professional 24 offices, as well as Butler's Courtyard, an award-winning special

event facility that has hosted more than 500 weddings since 2003;
 the League City Historical Society has recognized the building with
 a historic medallion; and

WHEREAS, The Butler Building holds a special place in the
chronicles of League City, and in its 100th year, it continues to
bring vitality to the historic center of town; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas

8 Legislature hereby commemorate the 100th anniversary of the 9 construction of the Butler Building in League City and extend best 10 wishes to all those associated with the preservation of this 11 venerable edifice.
