## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of the city of Crockett 2

gathering in Austin on April 15, 2009, to celebrate Crockett Day at

3 the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, The region where Crockett is located has played a 4

5 prominent role in Texas history; the town is situated on the route

of El Camino Real, or the Old San Antonio Road, which was used by 6

Spanish missionaries and other early settlers, and in 1836, Davy 7

Crockett is thought to have camped in the area on his way to the 8

Alamo; when the town was founded the following year, it was named in 9

Crockett's honor and became the seat of Houston County, the first 10

11 county established by the Republic of Texas; and

12 WHEREAS, Today, visitors can explore the area's history at a

number of notable sites, including the Rice Log Cabin, an original

stagecoach house now located at Mission Tejas State Park, and the

1909 Crockett Railroad Depot, which serves as a visitor center and 15

16 museum; another historic landmark is the Monroe-Crook House, built

in 1854 by a relative of President James Monroe, which reflects the 17

elegant architectural tastes of some of the city's early citizens; 18

this home and other vintage buildings in Crockett create a charming 19

20 atmosphere and make the town a popular stop on the Texas Forest

21 Trail driving route; and

22 WHEREAS, Crockett and surrounding towns boast a number of

23 other popular attractions, including the Houston County Fair,

Christmas in Crockett, the Peanut Festival in Grapeland, and the 24

- 1 Lovefest in Lovelady; moreover, the area has become a well-known
- 2 center for music, with numerous performances being presented by the
- 3 Dennis Ivey Texas Opry, the Piney Woods Fine Arts Association, the
- 4 Lovelady Old Gym, and other venues and organizations; special
- 5 events such as the World Championship Fiddler's Festival, the Texas
- 6 Forest Country Western Swing Festival, and gospel and bluegrass
- 7 festivals further enhance the community's musical offerings; and
- 8 WHEREAS, A productive area for business and industry, Houston
- 9 County is home to companies such as Vulcraft Group, the Christopher
- 10 Lumber Company, Earl's Apparel, Alloy Polymers, ElastoTech
- 11 SouthWest, P Chem, and the East Texas Medical Center, to name but a
- 12 few of the many enterprises that help drive the local economy; and
- 13 WHEREAS, County businesses benefit from the dedicated
- 14 efforts of the Crockett Area Chamber of Commerce, a member-driven
- 15 organization that provides valuable assistance to new and existing
- 16 companies and serves as an advocate and an information resource on
- 17 issues affecting local commerce; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The cooperative actions of the chamber are
- 19 indicative of the friendly, community-oriented outlook of
- 20 Crockett's citizens, whose actions have helped build an attractive,
- 21 livable, and prosperous town that is enjoyed by residents and
- 22 visitors alike; now, therefore, be it

- 24 Legislature hereby recognize April 15, 2009, as Crockett Day at the
