1 WHEREAS, A full and generous life came to an end with the
2 passing of George M. Turner of Austin on November 1, 2008, at the
3 age of 72; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Turner was the president of the State Employees
5 Golf Association of Texas at the time of his passing, and he had
6 held that office numerous times previously; he had a longtime
7 interest in the sport and had worked as a golf pro for many years at
8 several Austin courses; his extensive work with SEGA increased the
9 association's membership from 40 to more than 200, and during his
10 extraordinary tenure with the organization, he was considered the
11 SEGA "Ambassador of Golf"; and

12 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan was a U.S. Navy veteran and a
13 former state employee, and he also spent many years ranching in
14 Driftwood, where he was a charter member of the volunteer fire
15 department; moreover, his involvement in the community included
16 service as a deacon at Central Christian Church in Austin; and

17 WHEREAS, George Turner had kind words for everyone he met,
18 and he touched many lives with his tireless work in behalf of SEGA;
19 although he is deeply missed, he is remembered with admiration and
20 affection by all those who were privileged to share in his company;
