17 WHEREAS, Ms. Waters met her husband, fellow paramedic 18 Christopher Waters, while teaching a class at Central Texas College 19 in Killeen, and the couple enjoyed a close, loving relationship; 20 and

21 WHEREAS, Although her time on this earth ended far too soon, 22 Stephanie Waters lived out her dreams of flight and service to 23 others, and her joyful devotion to her calling will long be 24 remembered by all who shared in her love and friendship; now,
