WHEREAS, The Texas Public Policy Foundation is celebrating
 its 20th anniversary in 2009; and

3 WHEREAS, In the two decades since it was established, this 4 organization has been a tireless defender of the founding 5 principles of this great country: liberty, personal 6 responsibility, and free enterprise; and

7 WHEREAS, The foundation was organized in San Antonio in 1989 8 by a small group of civic-minded Texans who were inspired by the 9 effectiveness of the Heritage Foundation at the national level; 10 these citizens were determined to protect Texans' liberties and 11 freedom by using independent, market-based research to devise 12 solutions to problems confronting state government; and

WHEREAS, While the Texas Public Policy Foundation focused initially on education and tort reform, it has grown to become a broad-based research institute, the largest in the state guided by free-market principles; today, its purview encompasses taxation, government spending, criminal justice, health care, property rights, public infrastructure, consumer markets, and the environment; and

3 WHEREAS, Implementation of the foundation's proposals has 4 contributed to remarkable economic success in the Lone Star State; 5 Texas now leads the nation, or ranks near the top, in overall job 6 creation, overall financial condition, and the number of Fortune 7 500 companies headquartered in the state; moreover, Texas boasts 8 nearly the lowest per capita general revenue tax burden in the 9 country; and

WHEREAS, Early board members and advisors included former 10 president George W. Bush, Lieutenant Governor David Dewhurst, 11 12 Railroad Commissioner Michael Williams, Congressman Jeb Hensarling, and other influential leaders; the foundation's 13 14 current board of directors consists of members from a variety of 15 professions and industries, including law, medicine, oil, media, real estate, and academia; and 16

WHEREAS, Since its inception, the Texas Public Policy HereAS, Since its inception, the Texas Public Policy Foundation has grown in both influence and size, and today it ranks as a leading defender of freedom and liberty; with almost 20 employees and contracted experts and a budget of more than \$3 million, the foundation constitutes the largest state-based think tank in the nation and serves as an outstanding model for other free-market organizations; now, therefore, be it
