1 WHEREAS, Bowie Elementary School in Dallas was awarded
2 "Exemplary" status by the Texas Education Agency in 2008; and

3 WHEREAS, To ensure that all students in Texas benefit from
4 the highest standards of education, the TEA instituted an
5 accountability rating system for the state's public schools and
6 districts; a campus gains "Exemplary" status if at least 90 percent
7 of its students pass each of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and
8 Skills subject area tests, and in 2008, only 12 percent of all
9 schools earned this notable distinction; and

10 WHEREAS, Established in 1968, Bowie Elementary today has an
11 enrollment of approximately 450 students, and it provides early
12 childhood education as well as instruction through the sixth grade;
13 guided by the motto "Lighting the Way to the Future," Bowie
14 Elementary seeks to build a foundation of responsible citizenship
15 and lifelong learning for its students and to prepare them for the
16 challenges of tomorrow; under the leadership of principal Staci
17 Low, the faculty and staff also strive to give their pupils
