1 WHEREAS, For the third consecutive year, RISD Academy in
2 Dallas was awarded "Recognized" status by the Texas Education
3 Agency in 2008; and

4 WHEREAS, To ensure that all students in Texas benefit from
5 the highest standards of education, the TEA instituted an
6 accountability rating system for the state's public schools and
7 districts; a campus gains "Recognized" status if 75 percent of its
8 students pass each of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills
9 subject area tests, and in 2008, only 34 percent of all schools
10 earned this notable distinction; and

11 WHEREAS, An elementary school within the Richardson
12 Independent School District, RISD Academy serves 630 students in
13 the first through sixth grades; skillfully led by principal Carol
14 Johnson and assistant principal Lanette Massey, the faculty of RISD
15 Academy actively participates in the development of successful and
16 independent students, and the institution has been recognized with
17 the Texas Educator Excellence Grant for the 2008-2009 school year;
