R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Audelia Creek Elementary School in Dallas was
2 awarded "Recognized" status by the Texas Education Agency in 2008;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, To ensure that all students in Texas benefit from
5 the highest standards of education, the TEA instituted an
6 accountability rating system for the state's public schools and
7 districts; a campus gains "Recognized" status if 75 percent of its
8 students pass each of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills
9 subject area tests, and in 2008, only 34 percent of all schools
10 earned this notable distinction; and

11 WHEREAS, One of 41 elementary schools in the Richardson
12 Independent School District, Audelia Creek Elementary offers early
13 childhood education as well as instruction through the sixth grade;
14 known as the "Home of the Stallions," the school serves
15 approximately 600 students, and it is skillfully led by principal
16 Mike Savage and assistant principal Tonja Frazier; the mission of
17 Audelia Creek Elementary is to provide a world-class education to
18 all students; and

20 Elementary have demonstrated outstanding dedication and
21 perseverance in their pursuit of academic excellence, and they may
