

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Georgetown police officer Jason Chaudoin exhibited
2 swift and decisive judgment in an emergency, and his actions
3 contributed to the successful rescue of a local citizen in extreme
4 peril; and

5 WHEREAS, Officer Chaudoin joined fellow officer Erik Grasse
6 in responding to a report of an accident in Sun City; arriving at
7 the scene, they found a car submerged in a pond, with just its trunk
8 visible above the surface of the water; both officers dove in, and
9 Officer Chaudoin repeatedly plunged underwater in search of
10 passengers while Officer Grasse pulled the driver to safety;
11 Officer Chaudoin continued to search the water until the driver was
12 able to explain that she had been alone in the vehicle; and

13 WHEREAS, Thanks to the intervention of these two policemen,
14 the driver suffered no serious injuries, and she was treated and
15 released at the scene; and

16 WHEREAS, This valiant Texan is a tremendous asset to the
17 citizens of Georgetown, and he is truly deserving of special
18 recognition for his exemplary actions; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
20 Legislature hereby honor Officer Jason Chaudoin of the Georgetown
21 Police Department for his role in saving a woman from drowning and
22 extend to him sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it
