R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Montgomery County Republican Women,
2 North Shore Republican Women, and Lake Conroe Area Republican Women
3 are gathering in Austin on April 16, 2009, to celebrate Texas
4 Federation of Republican Women Day at the Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, The Texas Federation of Republican Women was
6 established in San Antonio in October 1955; with more than 300
7 delegates present, the organizing convention was led by Mrs.
8 Malcolm Milburn, and it resulted in the election of Mrs. R. D.
9 O'Callaghan as the first president; in the 53 years since its
10 inception, the organization's membership has grown to include more
11 than 10,000 participants in 167 chapters throughout Texas; and

12 WHEREAS, With the goals of educating women on the political
13 process, electing Republican candidates, and encouraging women to
14 run for office, TFRW produces quarterly publications and hosts
15 regular meetings that cover such issues as health, crime, and the
16 economy; the organization also works closely with the Republican
17 Party to train volunteers and provide support for local and
18 statewide campaigns; and

19 WHEREAS, This notable organization embodies a spirit of
20 public engagement, and its members may indeed reflect with great
21 pride on the exemplary model of citizenship they have set for their
22 fellow Texans; now, therefore, be it
