3 life in Arkansas, it is fitting to recognize her for her many
4 contributions; and

6 is a retired law department administrator for Union Pacific
7 Railroad, a position that she held for two decades, and she worked
8 for 18 years as director of the Union Pacific & Transportation
9 Employees Federal Credit Union; and

11 Mrs. Richardson has served as chair of the Irving Youth Action
12 Council, as a member of the City of Irving Community Development
13 Project, as president of the Greater Irving Republican Club, and as
14 a member of the Dallas County Council of Republican Women; she has
15 also performed the duties of team leader for the Irving branch of
16 America's Promise Alliance and served as a director of the Texas
17 Federation of Republican Women; and

18 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan enjoys membership at Irving
19 First United Methodist Church and has worked with Crossroads
20 Interfaith Housing Program, cofounding "That's Entertainment," a
21 benefit show for the program; she also serves as a spokesperson for
22 the American Cancer Society and the Susan G. Komen Foundation, and
23 has testified before two U.S. Senate committees on women's rights;
24 she has been honored with the Texas Senate Outstanding Volunteer

1 Award and Certificate of Recognition for her work with youth
2 leadership; and

3 WHEREAS, In all of her endeavors, Mrs. Richardson enjoys the
4 love and support of her husband, Bobby, to whom she has been married
5 for 48 years; their life together has been further enriched by their
6 son, Don, their daughter-in-law, Nicole, and their grandchildren,

9 dedication of committed individuals like Sue Richardson who give
10 freely of their talents and time in service to their fellow
