1           WHEREAS, Victor H. Hexter Elementary School in Dallas has  
2 been nominated for the 2009 No Child Left Behind--Blue Ribbon  
3 Schools award; and

4           WHEREAS, The Blue Ribbon Schools Program was created by the  
5 U.S. Department of Education in 1982 and was redesigned in 2002  
6 under the No Child Left Behind Act; to qualify for nomination,  
7 schools must demonstrate academic superiority within their state or  
8 show dramatic gains in student achievement; and

9           WHEREAS, Each year, the State of Texas designates up to 26  
10 schools to be considered for this distinguished accolade, and in  
11 2009, Victor H. Hexter Elementary School is among the select group  
12 of nominees representing the Lone Star State; with an enrollment of  
13 465 students in grades prekindergarten through fifth, this notable  
14 institution seeks to prepare all students for college, while  
15 embracing their individual talents and developing their potential;  
16 skillfully led by principal Jolee Healey, Hexter Elementary has  
17 obtained an Exemplary rating from the Texas Education Agency as  
18 well as an Excellence in Education Award for three consecutive  
19 years, and it has received the Texas Successful School System  
20 Award; and

21           WHEREAS, Through commitment, hard work, and perseverance,  
22 the teachers and students of Victor H. Hexter Elementary School  
23 have accomplished a record of academic achievement, and their  
24 outstanding efforts indeed merit special recognition; now,

3 Legislature hereby honor Victor H. Hexter Elementary School on its  
4 nomination for the 2009 No Child Left Behind--Blue Ribbon Schools
