16 more space, she moved Rosario's in 1999 to a new location, where she

18 enabled her to explore new opportunities and take on additional  
19 challenges; most recently, Ms. Wong opened Acenar on the San  
20 Antonio River Walk, and she is also a partner in the popular China  
21 Latina restaurant; and

22           WHEREAS, Lisa Wong has contributed greatly to the dining  
23 experience in San Antonio, and she may indeed take justifiable  
24 pride in her achievements and in the pleasure she continues to bring
