1           WHEREAS, Dr. Noel Nicholas Troxclair will celebrate his 60th

5           WHEREAS, Born on September 11, 1949, to Noel Jovita Volk  
6 Troxclair and Noel Nicholas Troxclair, Sr., in White Castle,  
7 Louisiana, Noel Troxclair grew up with three sisters, Jovita,  
8 Karen, and Mignon; he graduated from White Castle High School,  
9 where he was an avid runner and football player; he valiantly

11 and served in the Vietnam War; his college studies began at  
12 Louisiana State University, where he earned bachelor's and master's

16 University of Illinois Extension Service before relocating to  
17 Texas; in 1997, he began his employment as an extension  
18 entomologist and assistant professor of entomology at the Texas  
19 AgriLife Research and Extension Center in Uvalde, where he also  
20 participates in agricultural research efforts; and

21           WHEREAS, This dedicated teacher and scientist shares his  
22 expertise with youth agricultural programs such as 4-H and FFA  
23 Entomology, and he is a member of professional organizations such  
24 as the Society of Southwestern Entomologists, the Entomological

1 Society of America, and the International Organization for  
2 Biological Control; moreover, Dr. Troxclair has donated a great  
3 deal of his time in service to the Fellowship of Christian Athletes,  
4 the Christian Action Group, and the Boy Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Dr. Troxclair enjoys the  
6 love and support of his wife, Mary, his children, Caneel, Caleb, and  
7 Caitlin, and his grandchildren, Clair and Sadie; and
