

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The City of Irving has completed an extension of the
2 Campion Trails greenbelt into Sam Houston Trail Park, which offers
3 enhanced recreational opportunities for area residents; and

4 WHEREAS, Funded in part by the Dallas County Open Space
5 Program, the new section of Campion Trails extends from T. W.
6 Richardson Grove to Sam Houston Trail Park and provides a
7 pedestrian link to the greenbelt for residents of the Valley Ranch
8 development; and

9 WHEREAS, New features such as vehicle parking areas, security
10 lighting, and drinking fountains were included in the project;
11 moreover, picnic facilities, sports courts, and other amenities
12 will be added in a second stage of construction; and

13 WHEREAS, This new extension is an important addition to the
14 Campion Trails route, which will eventually form a 22-mile
15 greenbelt along the Elm Fork and West Fork of the Trinity River; and

16 WHEREAS, The creation of this impressive recreational trail
17 system further boosts the quality of life in Irving and provides yet
18 another example of the positive civic projects that make the city a
19 great place to live and work; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
21 Legislature hereby commemorate the completion of the Campion Trails
22 greenbelt extension to Sam Houston Trail Park in Irving and extend
23 to all those involved with the project sincere best wishes for
24 continued success.
