WHEREAS, For 150 years, many families have come together to
 celebrate their faith at the First United Methodist Church of Rio
 Grande City; and

WHEREAS, The history of this treasured institution dates back to 1859, when services were first held in the homes of area citizens; in 1875, Clemente E. Vivero was appointed the church's first minister, and four years later, construction began on the congregation's first facility; and

9 WHEREAS, At the Annual Conference of 1882, the Reverend Alex 10 Sutherland reported the completion of the new building, which cost 11 \$2,800 to construct; through the years, the church has kept pace 12 with the changing needs of the community it serves by expanding, and 13 a number of additions have been made, including a parsonage and an 14 annex; the church is also home to a kindergarten program that has 15 served Valley residents since 1947; and

WHEREAS, For 150 years, the First United Methodist Church of Rio Grande City has served as a source of strength and inspiration to those who have worshiped there, and the church stands as a tribute to the dedication of its members, past and present, who have devoted their time, prayers, and financial resources to ensure its continued existence as a house of God; now, therefore, be it
