    WHEREAS, Employed by a mortgage services company, Mr. Cowart met his future wife, Mary, in 1955, when she worked as his secretary; the couple were joined in matrimony on November 15, 1957, and they welcomed a son, Steven L. Cowart, in 1963; Mr. Cowart operated a private law practice, which he opened in downtown Houston and moved to Pasadena in 1974, and Mrs. Cowart took time off to raise their son, but then continued working alongside her husband as his secretary for nearly five decades; the couple nurtured a fulfilling relationship until Mrs. Cowart's passing in 2006; and
