- 12 secretary; the couple were joined in matrimony on November 15,
- 13 1957, and they welcomed a son, Steven L. Cowart, in 1963; Mr. Cowart
- 14 operated a private law practice, which he opened in downtown
- 15 Houston and moved to Pasadena in 1974, and Mrs. Cowart took time off
- 16 to raise their son, but then continued working alongside her
- 17 husband as his secretary for nearly five decades; the couple
- 18 nurtured a fulfilling relationship until Mrs. Cowart's passing in
- 19 2006; and
