- 14 and he has held such positions as state archeologist and both field
- 15 and survey archeologist; and
- WHEREAS, After joining Sul Ross State University in 1995, Mr.
- 17 Mallouf set out to expand the Center for Big Bend Studies, and in
- 18 the 13 years he served as its director, the program budget went from
- 19 \$15,000 to \$600,000, and 16 staff members were added; he also
- 20 expanded the center to allow for contractual archeology projects,
- 21 including one in Big Bend National Park, and he oversaw the launch
- 22 of a five-year research endeavor, the Trans-Pecos Archeological
- 23 Program; dividing his time between administering the program,
- 24 teaching, fund-raising, and excavating, Mr. Mallouf helped

- 2 attracted several million dollars in grants and private donations;
