R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Alumni of Texas A&I University are visiting the
2 State Capitol on April 8, 2009, to gain further insight into the
3 workings of state government as they pay tribute to their cherished
4 alma mater; and

5 WHEREAS, The oldest public institution of higher learning in
6 the region dates back to 1917, when it was chartered as South Texas
7 State Teachers College, and it officially opened its doors in 1925;
8 it was renamed Texas College of Arts and Industries four years
9 later, and it became known as Texas A&I University in 1967; with its
10 rich traditions, the university has built on its outstanding
11 reputation by expanding its mission and offering a wide array of
12 academic programs to meet the needs of a growing and diverse student
13 population; and

14 WHEREAS, Although the graduates of Texas A&I University have
15 gone on to make their mark on the world in a broad range of
16 disciplines, these accomplished men and women remain united in
17 their loyalty to the university that had such a deep and abiding
18 influence in shaping their lives, and they reflect on the years they
19 spent as "The Hoggies" with the utmost affection; and
