1 WHEREAS, Family-owned businesses are the backbone of Texas
2 communities, and for 52 years Gonzalez Place tavern has played a
3 vital role in the life of Weslaco; and

4 WHEREAS, The tavern was established on Texas Boulevard in
5 Weslaco in 1957 by Fidencio Martinez Gonzalez, who had emigrated
6 from Mexico at the age of 14 during the Great Depression; and

7 WHEREAS, Conceived from the beginning as a warm,
8 unpretentious gathering spot, Gonzalez Place soon became
9 inextricably woven into the social fabric of the community; and

10 WHEREAS, Over the years, the business has remained in the
11 Gonzalez family; Relio and Sergio Gonzalez, brothers of the
12 tavern's founder, played their part in managing the business, and
13 it is currently run by the founder's son, Daniel Fidencio Gonzalez;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, Today, Gonzalez Place is the oldest tavern in
16 Weslaco; while it maintains its traditional ties to the community,
17 it continues to be a welcoming place for new generations of Weslaco
18 residents to meet and relax; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
20 Legislature hereby commemorate the half-century history of
21 Gonzalez Place tavern in Weslaco and extend to the tavern's owners
22 and patrons sincere best wishes for continued good fellowship; and,
