- 23 his sweetheart, and the couple were married in Dallas on April 12,

- 2 volunteered for duty with the U.S. Navy, and he worked in the area
- 3 of radio technology and electronics until his discharge in 1946;

- 6 Kaye, Gail, and Bill, and established a successful sound-equipment
