

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Residents of Overton lost a beloved neighbor and a  
2 dedicated civic leader on March 18, 2009, with the passing of Mayor  
3 Robert Lee Young at the age of 67; and

4           WHEREAS, The son of M. Pete and Pauline Gill Young, Robert  
5 Young was born on November 4, 1941, in Henderson and was raised in  
6 East Texas; he went on to graduate from Overton High School, and he  
7 married the former Lana Laughlin in 1961; for more than three  
8 decades, he was employed by the U.S. Postal Service, and he retired  
9 as the Overton postmaster in 1997; and

10           WHEREAS, After serving for eight years on the Overton City  
11 Council, Mr. Young was elected mayor in 2005, and at the time of his  
12 passing he was in his second term of office; this esteemed Texan had  
13 also been president of the Overton School Board, and he was active  
14 in the Overton-New London Chamber of Commerce, which selected him  
15 as its Citizen of the Year in 2008; in addition, Mayor Young was  
16 honored with the State of Texas Outstanding Public Service Award;

18           WHEREAS, Involved in a number of local organizations, Mayor  
19 Young shared his time and talents with the Overton Golf  
20 Association, the Overton Cemetery Association, the Texas  
21 Association of Sports Officials, and the Circle Eight Square Dance  
22 Club, which he helped organize, and he was a former deacon at the  
23 First Baptist Church; and

24           WHEREAS, With a strong commitment to his community, Robert

1 Young enhanced the lives of countless individuals, and he will  
2 forever be treasured in the hearts of all those who were fortunate  
3 enough to know him; now, therefore, be it

4       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Robert Lee Young and  
6 extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife,  
7 Lana Young; to his daughters, Robbi and her husband, Mark Carnes,  
8 Nickie and her husband, Johnny Rhea, and Jennifer and her husband,  
9 Keith LaRue; to his brothers, Willard and Dudley Young; to his  
10 grandchildren, Kyle and Amanda Osburn, Stephen Bearden, Drake and  
11 Caden Plunkett, and Carissa Magras; to his great-grandchildren,  
12 Sydni Kyle Vaughn and Jesse Magras; and to his other relatives and  
13 many friends; and, be it further

14       RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
15 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of  
16 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Mayor  
17 Robert Lee Young.
