1           WHEREAS, Family and friends mourn the loss of Mary Ellen  
2 Hayman Lewis of Houston, who died on November 27, 2007, at the age  
3 of 78; and

4           WHEREAS, Mary Ellen Hayman was born in Ohio on July 23, 1929,  
5 to William Ray and Marie Sayre Hayman; she graduated as  
6 valedictorian of her class at Racine High School in 1947 and began  
7 her working life as executive secretary to the mayor of Columbus,  
8 Ohio; and

9           WHEREAS, In 1954, she moved to Texas, where she embarked on a  
10 career in the oil and gas industry that would span more than three  
11 decades; initially employed as a receptionist, she eventually  
12 worked in the field of regulatory compliance and retired in 1989;  
13 and

14           WHEREAS, Mrs. Lewis shared 47 years with her husband, Bill,  
15 and together they were blessed with three children; and

16           WHEREAS, Actively engaged in the life of her community, she  
17 was a member of the Tejas Chapter of the Daughters of the American  
18 Revolution, the United Daughters of the Confederacy, Heritage  
19 Republican Women, and other organizations; Mrs. Lewis also worked  
20 with the George Bush Foundation at Texas A&M University and was the  
21 sole trustee of the Bart and Helen De Laat Endowment Fund at the  
22 Colorado School of Mines; and

23           WHEREAS, Known as "Boots" to her loved ones, Mary Ellen Lewis  
24 was a devoted wife and mother, and a dedicated member of her

1 community, and she will forever hold a treasured place in the hearts  
2 of those whose lives she touched; now, therefore, be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Mary Ellen Hayman  
5 Lewis and extend sincere condolences to the members of her family:  
6 to her sons, William Gregg Lewis and his wife, Elaine, Jeff Lewis
