WHEREAS, During his school years, this energetic and outgoing young Texan served on the student council, participated in track and baseball, and earned membership in the National Honor Society; the son of a Baptist minister, he was also extremely involved in church activities, volunteering in the community and traveling on mission trips to Brazil and Mexico; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cunningham attended Texas A&M on a Navy ROTC scholarship, serving as company chaplain; after a year, he decided to follow in the footsteps of his older brother, John, and entered the United States Military Academy at West Point, where he graduated in 2006 as a first lieutenant with a degree in nuclear engineering; and
