3 Sour Lake Elementary School; and

4 WHEREAS, Students from the school were eating in the
5 cafeteria when Miss Grisham noticed that a third-grade student was
6 choking on his cereal; and

7 WHEREAS, After calling for a teacher and patting the boy on
8 the back, Miss Grisham, who is 10 years old, applied the Heimlich
9 maneuver on the stricken child and dislodged the food that was
10 blocking his airway; and

11 WHEREAS, The daughter of Callye and David Windsor of Sour
12 Lake, Miss Grisham has been recognized for her heroism with an
13 Outstanding Citizenship Award from the Sour Lake school board; and

14 WHEREAS, Angela Grisham's lifesaving actions helped to avert
15 a potential tragedy, and she is a source of great pride to her
16 family, school, and community; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
18 Legislature hereby commend Angela Grisham for rescuing another
19 student and extend to her sincere best wishes for a bright and
20 promising future; and, be it further

21 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
22 prepared for Miss Grisham as an expression of high regard by the
23 Texas House of Representatives.
