R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Junior high and high school students from Lighthouse  
2 Christian Academy in Canton are visiting the State Capitol on April  
3 17, 2009; and

4           WHEREAS, These notable young Texans have proven themselves  
5 scholastically exceptional by winning places on the A-B Honor Roll  
6 and by excelling in such extracurricular activities as  
7 cheerleading, basketball, softball, worship and interpretive
