RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The national service program AmeriCorps has proven 2 to be a highly effective way to engage Americans in a lifetime of 3 volunteerism while meeting a wide range of local and national 4 needs; and

5 WHEREAS, Since its inception in 1994, nearly 500,000 citizens 6 across the country and some 17,000 in Texas have taken the 7 AmeriCorps pledge to "get things done"; and

8 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members have accumulated more than 12 9 million hours in service, tutoring and mentoring disadvantaged 10 youth, fighting illiteracy, improving health services, building 11 affordable housing, teaching computer skills, cleaning parks and 12 streams, managing and operating after-school programs, helping 13 communities recover from disasters, and expanding the capacity of 14 nonprofit organizations; and

WHEREAS, In 2008, AmeriCorps in Texas provided opportunities 15 for approximately 1,600 people to address the unmet needs of 16 communities; these dedicated individuals subsequently recruited 17 18 supervised than 16,000 community volunteers, and more demonstrating that AmeriCorps in Texas is a powerful catalyst for 19 20 volunteer recruitment and engagement; and

21 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps distributed over \$10 million in grants in 22 Texas in 2008-2009, along with hundreds of millions of dollars in 23 additional funds and in-kind donations that were leveraged from 24 other sources; and
