RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, A vital and valued asset to the town of Danbury and
- 2 the surrounding area, the Danbury Post Office, in Brazoria County,
- 3 is celebrating its 100th anniversary on April 23, 2009; and
- WHEREAS, Danbury originated as a stop on the Missouri Pacific
- 5 Railroad, which built through the center of the county in 1905-1906
- 6 and opened up land that had previously been inaccessible; the
- 7 fertile soil of this section subsequently attracted a number of
- 8 farmers from the North and Midwest, and those settlers were
- 9 followed by many farmers of Czech descent; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Danbury Post Office opened on April 22, 1909, in
- 11 the Danbury Hotel, with Thomas B. Boring as postmaster; the
- 12 following year, the post office moved into the general store and the
- 13 store's proprietor, George L. Bradley, assumed postmaster duties;
- 14 when William A. Moller purchased the store later that year, he
- 15 simultaneously became the third postmaster of the young community;
- 16 and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Moller was succeeded by Daniel T. Taylor, who
- 18 served in 1912, William A. Griffing, 1912-1913, Alma McBride,
- 19 1914-1916, Robert E. McBride, 1917-1940, Eugene B. Griffing,
- 20 1940-1970, Esther A. Filipp, 1971-1992, Ron Smith, 1992-2007, and
- 21 Janie Norris, who has held the office since 2007; in addition, Mrs.
- 22 Clyde Gougenheim served as a postal clerk for 31 years and held the
- 23 position of officer-in-charge from February 1970 to May 1971; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Danbury Post Office moved into its own building

- 1 for the first time in the 1960s, and it remained there until 1998,
- 2 when a new post office building was constructed on Fifth Street; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Today, Danbury citizens celebrate their community
- 4 of approximately 1,700 residents as the Little Town with a Big
- 5 Heart, and the Danbury Post Office, with its friendly hometown
- 6 service, exemplifies the helpful, civic spirit that characterizes
- 7 this proud corner of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
- 9 Legislature hereby commemorate the 100th anniversary of the
- 10 establishment of the Danbury Post Office and extend to its staff and
- 11 patrons sincere best wishes for an enjoyable and memorable
- 12 celebration; and, be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 14 prepared for the Danbury Post Office as an expression of high regard
- 15 by the Texas House of Representatives.
