3 Officers' Memorial Ceremony on May 4, 2009, and this solemn event  
4 provides a fitting opportunity to honor those heroic public  
5 servants who placed themselves in harm's way to safeguard the lives  
6 and property of their fellow Texans; and

7           WHEREAS, Citizens throughout the state appreciate the brave  
8 officers who, by their selfless dedication to the public welfare,  
9 enable us to enjoy the benefits of a peaceful and orderly society;

11           WHEREAS, These men and women willingly risk their lives each  
12 day in order to investigate crimes and to patrol our roadways,  
13 communities, prisons, parks, and borderlands; moreover, they  
14 respond in times of crisis, and they also work to educate the public  
15 about crime prevention, adherence to the law, and safety awareness;

17           WHEREAS, Agent Clinton Brady Thrasher of the U.S. Department  
18 of Homeland Security exemplified in his professional conduct the  
19 virtues of courage, dedication, and fortitude throughout his 10  
20 years of service with the department; and

21           WHEREAS, On April 25, 2007, Clinton Brady Thrasher was killed  
22 in the line of duty, and his untimely death represents a tragic loss  
23 to his family, to his fellow officers, and to the entire community;

1           WHEREAS, The heroism of Clinton Brady Thrasher has earned  
2 this esteemed Texan our deepest gratitude, which the passage of  
3 time can never diminish; now, therefore, be it

4           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Agent Clinton Brady  
6 Thrasher of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and extend  
7 deepest sympathy to his loved ones; and, be it further

8           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
9 prepared for the members of his family and that when the Texas House  
10 of Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Clinton  
11 Brady Thrasher.
