1 WHEREAS, The congregants of the Greater Mount Olive

14 Church in October 1983, Reverend Lacey continues to faithfully
15 serve as pastor, teacher, counselor, mentor, and friend to his

18 speaker with the National Baptist Missionary Association of America
19 and as dean of the South Texas District Missionary Baptist
20 Association; and

23 Greater Mount Olive Baptist Church; in addition, he was named a
24 Leader in Christian Education by the National Baptist Sunday Church

3 Southeast Houston Chapter of the National Women of Achievement, and
4 honored by the Top Ladies of Distinction as one of Houston's
5 Outstanding Ministers; and

8 given of her time and gifts in behalf of myriad church activities,
