WHEREAS, Mr. Sterquell's foundation has grown in the years since to manage and maintain more than 14,000 units in 33 cities in 9 states; in recent years, he had worked with the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation to acquire more units, and recently he had begun creating affordable housing for seniors; and

WHEREAS, A leader in his profession, Mr. Sterquell taught courses in taxation, low-income housing credits, estate planning, and other subjects; he also found time to serve as chair and president of the Kiwanis Foundation, chair of the Children's Miracle Network Telethon, and president of the Children's Health Foundation, and he worked with Goodwill Industries, the Amarillo Community Center, and many other organizations; and
