1 WHEREAS, Since 1996, High Adventure Treks for Dads and 2 Daughters has provided outdoor educational opportunities for girls 3 that allow them to spend special time with their fathers; and WHEREAS, Known as HATS, the organization was created by Kipp 4 5 Murray, after he went on a backpacking trip with his son and realized that he wanted to have that same kind of experience with 6 7 his daughter, Megan; Mr. Murray recruited other citizens and set out to design a program for teaching girls in their early teens 8 advanced camping and wilderness survival skills and for fostering 9 meaningful relationships between fathers and daughters; through 10 11 the years, participation increased, and with a positive response 12 from the community, HATS grew to serve 140 residents of the Dallas 13 area; and 14 WHEREAS, Today, HATS operates as a nonprofit organization, and it continues to offer young women vital opportunities for 15 16 personal growth through community-based adventure activities, including canoeing, rock climbing, ropes courses, horseback 17 riding, orienteering, and camping; by challenging themselves 18 through these treks, the girls learn to work with their fathers to 19 accomplish their goals, and they develop confidence, strength of 20 21 conviction, and determination; in addition, HATS gives these youth lessons in responsibility, teamwork, compassion, and leadership, 22 23 as well as such practical training as first aid, and it assists them in understanding that they are capable of making wise choices as 24
