17 through the years, he always made his family a priority in his life,
18 attending numerous sporting events, selling countless Girl Scout
19 cookies, manning the Boy Scout Christmas tree lot, and brightening
20 the lives of others in myriad ways; and

21 WHEREAS, Hal Maddoux's generosity and kindness endeared him
22 to his family and many friends, and though his life ended much too
23 soon, memories of him will live forever in the hearts of all those
