- 14 and appellate law with an emphasis on commercial litigation, and he
- 15 was greatly respected for his knowledge, his professionalism, and
- 16 his confident and courteous manner in the courtroom; and

- 18 the McAllen Independent School District from 1996 to 2002,
- 19 including one year as president; moreover, he gave generously of
