14 her in her task of matching chairs to desks in the house chamber;

17 Texan is looking forward to devoting herself more fully to her
18 hobbies, which include sewing, cross stitching, bicycle riding,
19 target shooting, bowling, attending gun shows and cattle auctions,
20 and, especially, shopping; in addition, she plans to spend relaxed
21 mornings sipping coffee on the porch of her home while relishing the
22 fact that she no longer has to make a 100-mile round-trip commute to
23 and from downtown Austin each day; and

24 WHEREAS, Retirement will also allow Mrs. Simpson to spend

1 additional time with her family, which includes her husband, Terry
2 Simpson, her son, Bradly, and her grandchildren, Ash, Ty, and
3 Jaidyn; other members of the Simpson homestead include dogs, Hank
4 and Frank, miniature donkeys, Annie, Belle, Theresa, and Cheyenne,
5 and a few white-face Hereford cattle; and

6 WHEREAS, For more than a quarter-century, Bonnie Simpson has
7 provided important service to the members of this chamber, and she
8 may take justifiable pride in her many achievements as she begins
9 the next exciting chapter of her life; now, therefore, be it

11 Legislature hereby congratulate Bonnie Simpson on the event of her
12 retirement and extend to her sincere best wishes for continued
13 happiness in the years to come; and, be it further
