2 Campos of El Paso suffered an immeasurable loss with the death of
3 this valiant soldier on April 21, 2008, at the age of 22; and

4 WHEREAS, Assigned to Helicopter Sea Combat Support Squadron,
5 attached to the USNS Arctic, Airman Campos died in a
6 non-combat-related incident in Dubai; and

7 WHEREAS, Adrian Campos graduated from high school in 2003 and
8 joined the navy to see the world; he planned to open an auto shop
9 after completing his military service; beloved by many for his
10 outgoing and caring nature, he was a devoted husband to his wife,
11 Sylvia, and a proud father of his baby girl, Gaby; and

12 WHEREAS, Through his unfaltering devotion to duty, honor, and
13 country, Adrian Campos upheld the highest ideals of the United
14 States armed forces, and his fellow citizens owe him a debt of
15 gratitude that the passage of time can never diminish; now,
