R E S O L U T I O N

18 Lamar University, where he majored in political science and minored
19 in management information systems; while earning his degree, he
20 served in student government and was active in the Pre-Law Society
21 and the Model Arab League, representing his university in the
22 Political Affairs Council; Mr. Williams is also the founder of
23 Da'True Clothier and a cofounder, web developer, and design
24 consultant for SSISG; and

2 Williams has gained valuable work experience and firsthand
3 knowledge of the governmental process, while also developing
4 insight into the important issues facing our communities and our
5 state; and
