R E S O L U T I O N

11 serve as interns in the Texas Legislature, in state agencies, and in
12 local government offices; students receive academic credit for
13 participating in the program, which combines study and research
14 with supervised practical training; Senator Rodney Ellis serves as
15 a program advisor, and his office assists with coordinating on-site
16 activities; and

18 Southern Mississippi before moving to Texas, where he has worked in
19 the legal profession and the oil industry; a second-year student at
20 the Thurgood Marshall School of Law at Texas Southern University,
21 he plans to pursue a career in oil and gas law; and

22 WHEREAS, During his tenure as a legislative intern, Mr.
23 Stiles has gained valuable work experience and firsthand knowledge
24 of the governmental process, while also developing insight into the

1 important issues facing our communities and our state; and

4 Representative Farabee and ably assisted in meeting the needs of
5 constituents, and he may reflect proudly on his service as a
