R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to

6 participant in the Texas Legislative Internship Program (TLIP)
7 administered by the Mickey Leland Center on World Hunger and Peace
8 at Texas Southern University; and

10 opportunity for students from Texas colleges and universities to
11 serve as interns in the Texas Legislature, in state agencies, and in
12 local government offices; students receive academic credit for
13 participating in the program, which combines study and research
14 with supervised practical training; Senator Rodney Ellis serves as
15 a program advisor, and his office assists with coordinating on-site
16 activities; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Martinez is a third-year student at the Thurgood
18 Marshall School of Law at TSU, with a focus on government and
19 business law; during the 79th Legislative Session, he interned as a
20 Luna Scholar in the office of Senator Juan "Chuy" Hinojosa, and he
21 currently practices law with a temporary license for Garcia &
22 Martinez LLP in anticipation of his May graduation with a doctorate
23 of jurisprudence and a certificate in government law; and

24 WHEREAS, During his tenure as a legislative intern,

1 Mr. Martinez has gained valuable work experience and firsthand
2 knowledge of the governmental process, while also developing
3 insight into the important issues facing our communities and our
4 state; and
