18 first-generation college student, Ms. Egharevba is pursuing a  
19 double major in psychology and political science; she has  
20 previously served as an intern for Congresswoman Sheila Jackson Lee  
21 and for State Senator Rodney Ellis, and she plans to attend law  
22 school in the fall; and

23           WHEREAS, During her tenure as a legislative intern, Ms.  
24 Egharevba has gained valuable work experience and firsthand

1 knowledge of the governmental process, while also developing  
2 insight into the important issues facing our communities and our  
3 state; and

5 skillfully handled a variety of duties in the office of  
6 Representative Davis and ably assisted in meeting the needs of  
7 constituents, and she may reflect proudly on her service as a
