RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The 70th birthday of an esteemed Texan is a 2 significant milestone, and we are indeed honored that Barbara Jean 3 Fabrizio Fazio of Texarkana has chosen to celebrate this august 4 occasion at the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, The daughter of Ruth and Pinkie Fabrizio, the former 5 Barbara Fabrizio was born in Denver, Colorado, on May 8, 1939, and 6 7 grew up in a home behind her family's small grocery store; as a young girl, she exhibited precocious skill in the domestic arena, 8 9 cooking for her parents, her older sister, Donna, and her younger brother, Frank, and they also admired her housecleaning prowess, 10 despite her reputation as the family packrat; even before 11 12 graduating from South High School, she began attending beauty school, where her experiments on her own hair anticipated the 13 14 contemporary fashion for pink and purple locks; and

WHEREAS, She met John Fazio in 1959 when his air force career brought him to Colorado; they married two years later and, in 1964, became the parents of John Michael Fazio II; their second child, Rosetta Ruth, was born in 1974, shortly before the family moved from Colorado to New Boston, and the couple's youngest daughter, Elizabeth Ann, born in 1979, is a native Texan; and

WHEREAS, A Texan by choice rather than by birth, Barbara Fazio has made a positive difference in the lives of many through her devotion to education and to the rights of people with disabilities, and she has earned a special place in the hearts of all who are fortunate enough to know her; now, therefore, be it
