1 WHEREAS, The year 2010 marks the 30th anniversary of the 2 founding of Young Conservatives of Texas, and the Texas House of 3 Representatives is pleased to recognize this significant milestone 4 in the organization's history; and

5 WHEREAS, A group of 177 students met in Austin at the Stephen 6 F. Austin Hotel on Texas Independence Day, March 2, 1980, to 7 establish Young Conservatives of Texas; and

8 WHEREAS, A nonpartisan and independent youth organization, 9 Young Conservatives of Texas was founded to attract students who 10 believe in a conservative philosophy of government and to afford 11 those students the opportunity to participate effectively in the 12 political process; and

13 WHEREAS, YCT is dedicated to promoting its Statement of 14 Principles, including the beliefs that the Constitution was instituted for the protection of God-given rights, that 15 the American system of Federalism, describing limited government and 16 state sovereignty, serves to protect those rights, that economic 17 freedom and the free enterprise system are essential to liberty, 18 and that the aim of American foreign policy should be the protection 19 20 of the freedom of the American people; and

21 WHEREAS, For three decades, YCT has served as a strong force 22 on college campuses throughout the state, regularly hosting 23 speakers and events representing a wide range of conservative 24 thought; and
