1 WHEREAS, Nourish America rendered invaluable aid to
2 countless individuals in the aftermath of Hurricane Ike; and

3 WHEREAS, After this catastrophic event left more than two
4 million people without power, Nourish America responded quickly in
5 order to ensure that the residents of Northwest Houston were able to
6 have their vital need for nutrition and water met; and

7 WHEREAS, Led by executive director Michael Morton, the group
8 secured truckloads of supplies from its donors, and it collaborated
9 with Office Depot and the National Foundation for Women Legislators
10 to establish distribution centers, where they provided nutritional
11 products and hygiene items to thousands of hurricane survivors and
12 emergency workers; and

13 WHEREAS, Times of great crisis often inspire noble actions,
14 and Hurricane Ike proved to be no exception, as evidenced by the
15 generous support offered by Nourish America; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
17 Legislature hereby honor Nourish America for the important role it
18 played in the Hurricane Ike relief and recovery effort and extend to
19 all those associated with the organization sincere gratitude for
20 their hard work and dedication; and, be it further

21 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
22 prepared for Nourish America as an expression of high regard by the
23 Texas House of Representatives.
