2 Waco completed the requirements for attaining the rank of Eagle

17 scouting career, earning the respect and admiration of his fellow
18 scouts as he worked toward the highest rank that scouting offers;

21 perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to
22 stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride
