2 the Brock High School girls' basketball team claimed the 2009
3 University Interscholastic League 2A state championship with a
4 victory in the title game on March 7; and

5 WHEREAS, Matching up against the team from Woodville High
6 School, the Brock Lady Eagles combined relentless defense with a
7 high-powered scoring attack to build a double-digit lead in the
8 first half and then went on to register a commanding 61-32 win; and

9 WHEREAS, The 2008-2009 Lady Eagles carried on their school's
10 impressive winning tradition; Brock has now made 15 appearances in
11 the state tournament, and this year's championship was the school's
12 fourth since 2002; and

13 WHEREAS, In proving itself the state's finest 2A team, Brock
14 received outstanding contributions from each member of the squad:
15 Kamy Cole, Amy Edwards, Shelbi Jones, Savannah Fisher, Dana Jones,
16 Kambrie Shoush, Kayce Gilman, Payton Shoush, Dayla Jones, Hattie
17 Smith, Kenisha Harris, Haley Aaron, Paige Parliament, and Linsey
18 Hays; eight of the Lady Eagles received all-district honors this
19 season, and Ms. Harris was named the most valuable player of the
20 state tournament; and

21 WHEREAS, These talented student-athletes were guided by head
22 coach Skip Townsend and assistant coaches Chance Westmoreland and
23 Sammye Townsend, who provided the team with the skills, strategy,
24 and inspiration that took them to the top; and

1 WHEREAS, Winning a state title is the result of countless
2 hours of hard work and an enduring commitment to excellence, and the
3 members of the Lady Eagles basketball team may take justifiable
4 pride in this exceptional achievement; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
6 Legislature hereby congratulate the Brock High School girls'
7 basketball team on winning the University Interscholastic League 2A
8 state championship and commend the players, coaches, and staff for
9 a job well done during the 2008-2009 season; and, be it further
