4 WHEREAS, Born to Belinda Hart-Williams and Douglas Ford on  
5 April 13, 1989, Brandon Hart went on to become a star athlete at  
6 Woodville High School, where he helped the basketball team earn  
7 first place in the district; moreover, his love for running was  
8 evidenced by his impressive 2007 first-place victory at the Class  
9 2A Region III track championships, and he was highly regarded by his  
10 coaches and teammates not only for his outstanding athletic skills,  
11 but also for his kind and respectful nature; in addition, Mr. Hart  
12 served on the student council and as the senior class president  
13 before he graduated in 2007; and

14 WHEREAS, This generous young Texan was a role model to area  
15 youth as a coach of the Woodville Youth Football League and the  
16 Little Dribblers basketball team and through his work at Camp  
17 Niwana and the Boys and Girls Club of Lufkin, where he was named  
18 Employee of the Month; he was a student at Angelina College in  
19 Lufkin, and he had planned to transfer to Stephen F. Austin State  
20 University to pursue his goal of becoming a coach; and

22 he enhanced the lives of countless individuals with his bright  
23 smile, his strong faith, and his compassion; although his life  
24 ended far too soon, he will forever hold a special place in the
