- 17 Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Global War on Terrorism
- 18 Expeditionary Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, and the Combat Action

- 21 forces, Jonathan Markham inspired others with his loyalty and
- 22 patriotism, and all who knew and loved him will forever carry his
