R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, For nearly two decades, Dr. Fred M. Zaunbrecher of  
2 League City has operated a free medical clinic for homeless people  
3 in Galveston, and for this he has been named a 2009 Unsung Hero by  
4 the *Galveston County Daily News*; and

5           WHEREAS, Along with his wife, Michele, Dr. "Fritz"  
6 Zaunbrecher founded the Luke Society Clinic in 1980 to coordinate  
7 medical mission projects, and in 1995 they began the Luke Society  
8 Medical Mission to the Homeless, an outside clinic in Galveston  
9 staffed by volunteer physicians, nurses, and lay workers; the  
10 clinic, which is named for the biblical Luke who wrote about the  
11 compassion of Jesus, is open every Saturday and provides a range of  
12 care; and

13           WHEREAS, Dr. Zaunbrecher grew up in Louisiana, where he  
14 admired the work of his grandfather, a horse-and-buggy doctor; he  
15 and his wife decided to make their home on the Texas coast after  
16 moving to Galveston for a fellowship at The University of Texas  
17 Medical Branch, and he is today employed as an internist in Texas  
18 City; and

19           WHEREAS, Dr. Fritz Zaunbrecher has made a positive difference  
20 in the lives of many of Galveston's most vulnerable residents, and  
21 his outstanding humanitarian efforts are indeed deserving of  
22 recognition; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
24 Legislature hereby congratulate Dr. Fred M. Zaunbrecher on being
